




AC MAX Basic Firmware Update Manual

1. Install the Delta AC MAX App on your Smartphone





2. Start the app and search the wallbox via Bluetooth

Grant the necessary permissions.

Compare the serial number displayed in the app with the one at the type label of AC MAX.

Note: If the app does not find the wallbox, you have to set the 2nd dip switch of the wallbox to ON (right) and restart the wallbox.



Make sure you disconnect the wallbox from the power supply when you are changing the dip switch!

3. Connect to the wallbox

The app prompts you to pair the smartphone with the wallbox.
Bluetooth pairing code: 882570

Note: If the Bluetooth software of the wallbox is outdated, the app will update it automatically but needs to download the Bluetooth firmware file from the web. Therefore, please ensure the smartphone is connected to the internet. Leave the smartphone unpaired until the Bluetooth chip is updated. Then pair the smartphone with the wallbox using the Bluetooth pairing code given above.

4. Log in and update the firmware

Login Password: 1234567890123456

The app navigates to the firmware update page automatically and downloads the firmware file from the web. Start the firmware update.

Note: If your smartphone has no internet connection, close the app, move to a location where your smartphone can connect to the internet and open the app again. It will automatically start to download the firmware update file. After that, go back to the wallbox, reconnect and perform the firmware update.

5. Store the new Bluetooth pairing code and login information

After updating to the current firmware version, the wallbox has an individual Bluetooth pairing code and login password. Both are displayed in the app and must be noted down. This information is required for the future connection between smartphone and app.

Note: Even after updating the wallbox's firmware, it may be necessary to update the Bluetooth chip.

Disconnect the Bluetooth pairing between smartphone and wallbox. To do this, go to the settings of the operating system. The app will inform you about this step if necessary.

Reconnect to the wallbox and reset the wallbox to factory settings

Open the app, search for the wallbox, pair the Bluetooth connection and log in. The new pairing code and password are required. Tap on the gear wheel at the bottom of the screen, navigate to the reset to factory page and reset the wallbox.

Note: If the app cannot find the wallbox after the firmware update, delete the Bluetooth pairing information in the operating system settings. The wallbox is named there by its serial number.

6. Configure the charging authentication mode

After updating the wallbox, you can decide whether you want to use the app (Bluetooth) to start a charging process or you prefer activation via key switch.

Make sure you disconnect the wallbox from the power supply when you are changing the dip switch!

Note: Even if you choose the activation via key switch, you can further connect to the wallbox to change settings or update the firmware without changing the dip switch again.
